

Marriage License

Missouri State requirements for a marriage license are as follows:

- Application for your marriage license should be made at the St. Louis County Office (see below)
- Both the bride and groom must appear in person.
- The fee is currently \$48 and only cash is accepted. You will be charged \$9 for a certified copy and you need this for the License Bureau and some banks.
- After a 3-day waiting period, the license is then issued.
- The marriage license is void 30 days from the date of its issuance.
- The license must be given to the Pastor prior to the ceremony; he is not permitted by law to officiate at a wedding without the license in his possession.
